I am writing this edition of the HOA News on April 15th. Folks in the US realize that on this date, "The Tax Man Cometh & Tax Man Taketh Away!" Now that tax season is gone, let's move on.

This past Saturday we just had our second free smoke detector installation for the residents of Colonial Colony South. Here are some facts: starting at 8:30am approximately 60 volunteers met at the south clubhouse for a briefing on smoke detector installation and directions with names and addresses of the residents receiving them. There were 35 young adults from various Red Cross Clubs, 3 Daytona Beach Fire Department personnel, 1 fire truck, 6 Red Cross employees, 3 vehicles, 20 resident volunteers, and golf carts. We had 9 dozen donuts for the pre-installation meeting, 70 bottles of water, and 72 cans of coke during the installations and the Red Cross provided 18 pizzas for lunch. We finished up around 1pm. The results are astounding, 100 homes, 217 alarms, 157 residents protected for fire. This is another example of your HOA providing something very important for ALL residents, members, and non-members.
